# School Updates 2024/06 (Secondary 1)

## 1. Early leave from school

## 3. CCA Dates

CCA will stand down on **Tuesday**, **17 September 2024** before End of Year exam. It resumes on **Tuesday**, **15 October 2024** and it will also be the last CCA for semester 2. You will be notified separately by the respective CCA Teachers-in-charge if there are CCA trainings scheduled during the school holidays.

# 4. End-of-Year Examination

The End-of-Year examination will begin with the English Language Paper 1 (for G1, G2 and G3 subject levels) and Mother Tongue Languages Paper 1 (for G1 Tamil Language, G2 and G3 Chinese and Malay Languages ) on **Monday, 23 September 2024**. The second part of the examination will be conducted from **Tuesday, 1 October 2024** to **Thursday, 10 October 2024**.

Please advise your child/ward to follow the examination timetable strictly and to be in school punctually for each paper. We will brief your child/ward on the Examination Rules and Expectations before the commencement of the examination. The timetable and topics for each subject to be tested for the End-of-Year Examination can be found on the school website.

Please note that during the examination period, there will be **no late reporting on Wednesdays**, that is, **2 October 2024** and **9 October 2024**.

Students who are taking the first paper of the day shall report to school by 0727 for flag raising. For students with oral assessment for their language subjects, they will be informed of the individual order in the assessment group. Each student will take about 10 to 15 minutes and student can take their leave after their turn. The entire oral assessment will take approximately 2hrs to 2hrs 30 minutes. For safety reasons, students are not allowed to leave the school during the interval between papers. Students will be dismissed from school immediately after his/her last paper of the day.

We would like to draw your attention to the following:

(a) Students who are unwell will need to seek medical consultation and provide a **Medical Certificate** for their absence. Otherwise, the student will be considered absent without valid reason and awarded a zero mark for that paper.

(b) Any student found cheating, or attempting to cheat, will be given a zero mark for the subject and may be barred from the rest of the examination. Mobile phones and smartwatches **must be left in their bags and must be switched off at all times during the examination. In line with National Examination regulations,** students found with mobile phones and/or smartwatches in their possession will be deemed as attempting to cheat, regardless of whether the electronic device is switched on or not.

(c) Students who do not observe the rules for presentable appearance (e.g. shoes, hairstyle, and fingernails) may be barred from sitting for the examination and awarded a zero mark.

We seek your support in supervising your child/ward in his/her revision, and in ensuring that he/she prepares himself/herself adequately for the examination.

Please also note that **Monday**, **14 October 2024**, is the school's Marking Day and **Monday**, **21 October 2024**, is the school's Result Processing Day. Your child/ward will **not** need to come to school on that day.

## 5. Crestian Learning Day (Student-Initiated Learning)

**Friday, 11 October 2024** is a Crestian Learning Day (CLD) dedicated for students to pursue and complete the Student-initiated Learning (SIL) project, focusing on our Applied Learning Programme and Effective Communications. The objective of SIL is to provide opportunity for students to be self-directed in their learning and exploration of the various forms of communications to strengthen their clarity in the articulation and expression of their thoughts and perspective, while at the same time improving their digital literacies. The challenges for the various levels are:

Secondary 1 – Creating an Infographic

Secondary 2 – Creating a BookTok

Secondary 3 – Learning a new language using Duo-Lingo

Students have been briefed on SIL in semester 1 and the activity can be found in SLS. They will be sharing their SIL projects digitally, towards the end of the school term.

## 6. Inter-class Games

The school will organise the Inter-class games for all Secondary 1 students on **Friday**, **18 October 2024**, from 8.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.. The objectives of the games are to allow the students to play and demonstrate their learning of the sports that they have been taught during Physical Education (PE) lessons, build teamwork among the students, inculcate values like respect, sportsmanship and encourage students to lead a healthy lifestyle.

Students will report in their PE t-shirt and school pants/skirt for that day. Students are reminded to hydrate themselves well and have at least 7 hours of uninterrupted sleep the night before. They are advised to have their breakfast before they come to school as they will have recess only from 10.30 a.m. to 11.20 a.m.. Lessons will be as per normal from 11.20 a.m. onwards after the Inter-class Games.

### 7. Mathematics Intensive Remediation Programme (MIRP) (For G2 and G3 Mathematics only)

In order to provide additional help for students who have not performed satisfactorily in Mathematics during the End of Year Examination, the school will conduct the Mathematics Intensive Remediation Programme (MIRP). The MIRP serves as a timely intervention to help students to consolidate their learning and address their learning gaps before the next academic year.

<u>MIRP Details</u> Date: 28 October to 1 November 2024 Time: 7.30 a.m. to 10.00 a.m.

Only selected students will be required to attend the MIRP. More information will be released via Parent Gateway nearer to the date of the programme.

## 8. Lost & found

Students who find lost items at school typically turn them in to the General Office. If the owner of the item can be identified, such as with a wallet containing a student ID, we will notify the student to collect their item from the General Office. For items that do not facilitate the identification of owners, such as water bottles, students have been advised to check the shelf outside Consult@Crest and to inquire with the General Office and record a loss..
